



Venues for 2019

Should I be fortunate enough to be re-elected as the Tournaments Officer for 2019 I need clubs to help with hosting the National events.

Currently all the outdoor events need a club to host them and in exchange for the 2-day event EFAA pay the club £500. In exchange the club is asked to provide a 28-target course, (or 2 x 14 for the spot shoots), a practice area, a couple of marshals who know the course and a couple of loos. The EFAA provide everything else.

Catering and raffle can be a welcome additional income for the host club, but if it is stopping you or worrying you then please do speak with me as there are options that we can use to help.

If you do not have a venue but have a team of people who would like to host the event we have clubs who for part of the fee would be willing to allow their woods to be 'hired'.

If you only have 14 targets but space to fit another 14 targets in then please talk to me and we will endeavour to support you in organising the second 14.

We also can use other non EFAA grounds as long as there are three EFAA members who would act as hosts.

We need

Spring Championships – usually held 4th and 5th May – a quieter shoot and a good one to start on.

National Championships – usually held 2nd weekend in September however this could be moved to the clubs' 'normal' weekend if it helps

Bowhunter Championships – usually held in June with the dates being flexible around the international competitions.

3D Championships – usually held in October again the date can be flexible around international events

Please note: if a club has their own 3D's and would prefer to use them for the animal events then the EFAA is willing to pay an additional fee of £500 for wear and tear of the animals.

It is first come first served with any of the above events and all you need do to secure an event I to email me on tournaments@efaafieldarcher.com telling me what event you would like to host, proposed dates and contact details of the person from the club.
