EFAA Vice-President Hand Over Documentation

The Constitution:

Vice-President shall:

(1) Perform the duties of the President if the President is unable to act.

Main Role

The Role

The Vice President shall:

- 1. Ensure that the EFAA acts in accordance with its constitution, rules and regulations at all times, bringing any issues to the notice of the President and the EFAA committee.
- 2. Act as an Executive member of the EFAA, acting at all times as an advocate for the organisation.
- 3. Provide advice and support to the president, the Executive Committee and the wider committee as required, this may include but is not restricted to:
 - a. Disciplinary matters
 - b. Supporting committee members settle into new roles
 - c. Respond to queries raised by members in a timely manner
 - d. Monitor social media platforms and report to the respective officers any untoward issues
- 4. Step into any of the Committee positions should it be required or offer additional support dependant on the circumstances.
- 5. Act into the President role should the President become unwell or unfit to undertake the role
